SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY WEEK

WHEREAS: School psychologists are among the most highly trained educators and are instrumental in helping the next generation of Georgians thrive. They work directly with students, teachers, and parents to meet the special learning needs of our children; and

WHEREAS: School psychologists perform evaluations and comprehensive assessments that help identify children's educational strengths and weaknesses, making effective recommendations that will address individual requirements; and

WHEREAS: Teachers consult with school psychologists in planning for the instructional needs of individual students in regular and special classrooms and for information concerning learning principles, social behavior, classroom management, and academic behavior; and

WHEREAS: School psychologists provide family counseling and help facilitate relationships between students, parents, teachers, and school administrators, thereby fostering a better understanding of a child's problems and special educational needs; and

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia actively acknowledges and supports school psychologists and their work to improve the learning environment of our state's children; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim November 8-12, 2021 as SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY WEEK in Georgia.
